STRAIGHT STAKE POCKET TIE DOWN INSTALLATION

(Applicable truck models listed on Page 1)

MATERIALS INCLUDED WITH PURCHASE:

- Magnum Headache Rack (1)
- Straight Stake Pocket Tie Downs (2) with required bolts (2), washers (2), and aluminum spacer (1)
- Modular Wire Harness (1) Only included if you purchased a lighted headache rack

STEP 1: Remove side bolt from the stake pocket tie down



STEP 2: Insert tie down into the stake pocket using the top bolt



STEP 3: While using the top bolt to line up the holes, insert side bolt into tie down through the inside of truck bed



STEP 4: Align tie down at the top of the stake pocket and tighten side bolt



STEP 5: Remove the top bolt from the tie down, in preparation for the rack install




Repeat steps 1-5 on the other side of truck

STEP 6: Align rack evenly on both bed rails (if bed rail has plastic liner, rack foot must be aligned fully on plastic, NO OVERHANG) - Insert top bolt through rack foot into the stake pocket and hand tighten



STEP 7: Tighten top bolts on both rack feet





If you purchased a lighted headache rack, proceed to page 4

ANGLED STAKE POCKET TIE DOWN INSTALLATION

(Applicable truck models listed on Page 1)

MATERIALS INCLUDED WITH PURCHASE:

- Magnum Headache Rack (1)
- Angled Stake Pocket Tie Downs (2) with required bolts (2), washers (2), and aluminum spacer (1)
- Modular Wire Harness (1) Only included if you purchased a lighted headache rack

STEP 1: Remove side bolt from the stake pocket tie down



STEP 2: Insert tie down into the stake pocket using the top bolt

(Note: Angled Tie Downs are manufactured specific to driver and passenger side stake pockets - confirm hole for side bolt is facing inside of bed rail toward truck bed)



STEP 3: While using the top bolt to line up the holes, insert side bolt into tie down through the inside of truck bed



STEP 4: Align tie down at the top of the stake pocket and tighten side bolt




STEP 5: Remove the top bolt from the tie down, in preparation for the rack install



Repeat steps 1-5 on the other side of truck

STEP 6: Align rack evenly on both bed rails (if bed rail has plastic liner, rack foot must be aligned fully on plastic, NO OVERHANG) - Insert top bolt through rack foot into the stake pocket and hand tighten



STEP 7: Tighten top bolts on both rack feet

WARNING: Tighten bolts to secure rack but do not over-torque

DRILL & BOLT INSTALLATION

MATERIALS INCLUDED WITH PURCHASE:

- Magnum Headache Rack (1)
- Bolts (4)
- Washers (4)

• Modular Wire Harness (1) -Only included if you purchased a lighted headache rack



STEP 1:

Align rack evenly on both bed rails (if bed rail has plastic liner, rack foot must be aligned fully on plastic, NO OVERHANG)



STEP 2:

Drill holes through openings on rack feet directly through the bed rail of the truck



STEP 3:

Insert and tighten all four bolts in newly drilled holes

MARNING: Tighten bolts to secure rack but do not over-torque

If you purchased a lighted headache rack, proceed to page 4

CLAMP INSTALLATION

MATERIALS INCLUDED WITH PURCHASE:

- Magnum Headache Rack (1)
- Mounting Clamps (4)
- Modular Wire Harness (1) -Only included if you purchased a lighted headache rack



STEP 1:

Align rack evenly on both bed rails (if bed rail has plastic liner, rack foot must be aligned fully on plastic, NO OVERHANG)



STEP 2:

Insert two provided clamps into cargo management track (located inside of bed rail) on each side and hand tighten clamps to rack foot and bed rail



STEP 3:

Tighten the four inserted clamps until headache rack is secure to truck

WARNING: Tighten bolts to secure rack but do not over-torque

MODULAR WIRE HARNESS

7-WAY TRAILER HARNESS INSTALLATION

Required for lighted Magnum headache racks installed using one of the following methods:

- Straight Stake Pocket Tie Downs
- Drill & Bolt
- Clamp

STEP 1: Feed headache rack wire harness down between cab and bed of truck



STEP 2: At rear of truck. locate and unplug the 7-way trailer harness plug



STEP 3: Attach modular wire harness to 7-way trailer port and re-attach plug from Step 2 to the second port on modular wire harness



STEP 4: Run modular wire harness to front of the truck and attach to headache rack wire harness



STEP 5: Secure remaining loose/hanging wires to truck using zip-ties and electrical tape



MARNING: Chase wire and secure in areas to avoid pinching, splicing, overheating, and any potential moving parts under or around underside of truck frame

TAIL LIGHT/BODY CONNECTION HARNESS INSTALLATION

Required for lighted Magnum headache racks installed using one of the following methods:

Angled Stake Pocket Tie Down

STEP 1: Feed headache rack wire harness down between cab and bed of truck



STEP 2: (Ford F-150 ONLY)

At rear of truck, locate and remove bolt for ground wire and attach ground wire from modular wire harness and retighten bolt to secure to truck.



WARNING: Magnum recommends using a ratchet and socket to remove and re-insert bolt to truck. Using motorized tools could lead to stripping of bolt and inability to secure bolt.

STEP 3: At rear of truck, locate and unplug tail light harness/body connection (location of plug may differ from make/model of truck)



- F-150 connection located on driver side by spare tire
- Super Duty connection located on passenger side by spare tire

STEP 4: Attach modular wire harness to tail light/body connection port and re-attach plug from Step 3 to the second port on modular wire harness



STEP 5: Run modular wire harness to front of truck and attach to headache rack wire harness



STEP 6: Secure remaining loose/hanging wires to truck using zip-ties and electrical tape



MARNING: Chase wire and secure in areas to avoid pinching, splicing, overheating, and any potential moving parts under or around underside of truck frame
